Monday: Make Room for God – Matthew 6:17-18

- 1. So what gets in the way of God during your Christmas?
- 2. Ask God to help you set aside something for a day (or more) as you make room for God to do something big in your life.

Tuesday: Do You Hear What I Hear? - Matthew 11:28-30

1. Practice "Listening Prayer." Practice asking God throughout the day, "What is Your Will for me right now?" And then listen. Listen until you hear an answer. And then Act! WARNING! This may slow you down and make you WAIT, but isn't that the goal?

Wednesday: Let it Go, Let it Go, Let it Go – Isaiah 43:17-18

1. Christmas is the time for new beginnings. God says to you today, "Do not dwell on the past." He is doing a new thing in your life. Let go of the past, confess those sins and receive God's grace that will make a new way. Let this Christmas be a new birth for you.

Thursday: Do You See What I See? – Philippians 1:9-11

- 1. Examine your spiritual growth as you wait using "The Prayer of Examen"
 - a. Review the past 24 hours
 - b. Write down or list in your head all your encounters and activities during that time.
 - c. Give thanks for the times you were obedient to God.
 Confess your sins when you discover that you've gone your own way.

Friday: Here We Go A Serving – Hebrews 9:14

- 1. How can you serve God in the weeks ahead?
- 2. What acts of kindness and mercy can you share with those around you?
- 3. Who needs to see God's love manifested through your humble service?

Saturday: A Silent Night – Habbakkuk 2:20

1. As you prepare for worship tomorrow, plan some silence into your personal worship. Maybe you leave early and sit silently in the sanctuary, or send the other people into church and stay in the car for a few moments just being still. God wants to meet you as you wait
