IMAGINE

Monday: Eyes of Your Heart - Ephesians 1:18

- 1. What keeps you from being passionate in your prayer and worship?
- 2. Do you see God's promises as yours in Christ?
- 3. Use your imagination and ask God to open the eyes of your heart.

Tuesday: Just Imagine – Philippians 1:27-28a

- 1. What would you have to lay down and/or pick up to increase the quality of living a gospel-centered life?
- 2. What would it look like if everyone in our congregation did the same thing?

Wednesday: I Surrender All – Samuel 1:10

- 1. What are you holding back from God?
- 2. What would it look like for you to surrender even that to God?
- 3. Are you willing to do it?

Thursday: What Would It Look Like? - Hebrews 10:24-25

- 1. What if we, as brothers and sisters in Christ, committed ourselves to encouraging one another, holding one another accountable to staying committed in our growing relationship with Jesus?
- 2. What do you imagine the church would look like?
- 3. How might it change?
- 4. How might you be part of the process?

Friday: To Infinity and Beyond – Ephesians 3:20-21

- 1. Is it possible that we "limit" God to things we can grasp and understand?
- 2. Don't limit God with what you can understand. Lay it all out before God believing that God can do the impossible.
- 3. What spiritual needs do you have that you haven't trusted to God?
- 4. Whose salvation do you long to see?

Saturday: It Can Be Reality - Matthew 22:37-40

- 1. Imagine a world, or even your church, where every Christian is fully obeying these two commands: Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and love your neighbor as yourself.
- 2. Imagine what would be missing (gossip, hurtful words, etc.)
- 3. Imagine what we would experience in our community of faith.
- 4. Imagine what would happen if you started today. What would need to change in your own life?
